Social and Behavioral Sciences Requirement

(must be from two different subject areas)

- Lower level Economics, Politics, Psychology, or Sociology Course
- Lower level Economics, Politics, Psychology, or Sociology Course

Foreign Language Requirement

Completion of one semester of a Foreign Language at the 200 level or higher.

Electives (Optional)

A student must complete a minimum of 120 hours between required course work and elective courses.

Humanities Requirement

Choose one of the following courses in addition to the General Education requirement:

- Art History: Any 200 level and higher course
- English and Comparative Literature: Any course
- Foreign Language: Any 300/400 level course
- Philosophy: PHI 204, PHI 205, or PHI 206
- Politics: POL 341, POL 342, or POL 441
- Theatre: THE 210, THE 220, or THE 305
- Women's and Gender Studies: Any 200 level and higher course

Social Sciences Requirement

Choose one of the following courses in addition to the General Education requirement:

- Economics ECO 290, ECO 320, ECO 323, ECO 324, ECO 400, ECO 424, ECO 425, ECO 490
- Math MAT 111
- Politics Any 200 level and higher course (except POL 341, POL 342, or POL 441)
- Sociology Any 200 level or higher course (except SOC 303, SOC 304, SOC 402, or SOC 405)
